The Utah Association of Counties is seeking a skilled Software Developer to support its custom software applications. This individual will be responsible for implementing business logic, managing data configurations, and integrating Power BI and Power BI Embedded for advanced reporting. This individual will play a critical role in designing, developing, and maintaining scalable web APIs, services, and data-driven applications. The role requires strong database development skills, experience with Microsoft Azure, and passion for delivering clean, efficient, and impactful code. The ideal candidate will thrive in a collaborative environment and contribute to the evolution of our system architecture.

Key Responsibilities

1. Application Development

- o Design and develop scalable APIs and application features based on business requirements.
- o Write clean, efficient, and maintainable code using C# and .NET.
- o Revise, refactor, and debug code to improve performance and reliability.
- o Implement business logic and data configurations to support API actions.

2. Data & Reporting Integration

- o Integrate Power BI and Power BI Embedded into web applications.
- o Develop and manage SQL Server databases, including data modeling and querying.
- o Maintain and organize API documentation and collections using Postman.

3. Collaboration & Architecture

- o Participate in requirements gathering and technical planning sessions.
- Collaborate with cross-functional teams to ensure alignment with overall system architecture
- O Contribute to the design and evolution of system architecture and development best practices.

4. Testing & Support

- o Participate in application testing, including unit, integration and user acceptance testing.
